Cantina Zaccagnini Brut Blanc de Blancs IGT, Italy

100% Chardonnay

The wines of Zaccagnini consistently outperform their price point, and their Blanc de Blanc Brut is no exception! However, many people just don't know about this fabulous bubbly because the focus is so often on their still red, Montepulciano d'Abruzzo. Thus, we figured it was time to get this in the hands of the masses to be enjoyed during your Holiday celebrations!

Cantina Zaccagnini Brut Blanc de Blancs IGT NV is an elegant Italian sparkling wine crafted from Pecorino grapes, offering freshness and finesse in every sip. It opens with aromas of green apple, citrus, and white flowers, leading to crisp flavors of lemon, apple, and almond balanced by fine bubbles. Bright, toasty, and refined, it pairs beautifully with seafood, salads, and soft cheeses.

Le Monde Pinot Nero Rosé Brut, Italy

100% Pinot Nero

A subtle, bouquet which recalls red berry fruit, currants and raspberries, with flowery notes of rose petals. Lively and enjoyable, with a defined red fruit flavor. The acidity typical of this grape variety is perfectly balanced by a likable sugar content. Best with delicate flavors and ideal as an aperitif to accompany less mature cured meats or raw fish.

Le Monde takes its name from the Germanic word "mundio" that referred to the protection granted by the Austrian Emperor to some lands. With 50 hectares (125 acres) of vineyards, Le Monde was founded in 1970 by the Pistioni family and taken over by the Maccan family in 2008. The Maccan family is from the Prata di Pordenone area and became quite successful in industrial technology. The family had the desire to lift the quality of wine in the region to its highest potential. Alex Maccan, 31, passionate about wine was energized and enthusiastic to take on the task.

Nearly a millennia ago under the dominion of the Republic of Venice, the region of Prata di Pordenone started to gain importance as an agricultural region. Le Monde is a territory lying within this region between the Livenza and Meduna rivers, close to the border between the provinces of Treviso and Pordenone, all within the D.O.C of Friuli Grave. The "Serenissima" (Venetian Republic), built Venetian villas in this area and developed its agricultural resources in nearby farms located along watercourses connecting them to the Venetian Lagoon.
